DEAR FRIENDS:

Over 30 years ago, our founders understood that parents make an enormous difference in their child's ability to learn and grow. They also understood the value of community-based access to resources and information. Now, thirty years later, our mission and values remain steadfast. We warmly welcome every family, from as soon as their child is born until well into kindergarten.

We start at birth because learning isn't a switch that magically turns on when children begin school. It's a journey that is nurtured from birth. There are only 2,000 days between the time a baby is born and when that child begins kindergarten. 90% of critical development happens in that time. So the earlier we can engage parents in their child's learning, the better! Our family literacy playrooms in the libraries and our centers, parent coaching in homes, and our family programs in our community schools support this connection.



The range of programs we offer and the diversity of families we serve is what has drawn us to Family Connections. It is the breadth and depth of our services that sets us apart. It is the fact that we can build a relationship with one family at the very beginning of their parenting journey and stay with that family well into their child's elementary school years. It is the fact that we can help steer that family to the resources they need – whether we provide the service or another organization does so. For most of our programs, there is no registration, no waiting period, no insurance card required. We are there when you are ready to pull your hair out or when you are struggling with your child's academic problems. And we are there when you share your joys and milestones.

We have come a long way from our initial service of 126 families, but we still have a long way to go. We invite you to imagine with us what our neighborhoods, our schools and our families would look like if every parent had the benefit of the services we provide: if every parent knew how to handle their child's unique and often challenging issues; if every parent understood the developmental stages their children were going through, if every parent embraced the importance of reading, playing, singing, talking with their young children. Imagine with us what our schools would look like if every child started kindergarten ready to learn, if school was just one more step in a journey of lifelong learning that had started at birth. Imagine with us what our communities would look like if all families were supported, engaged and connected, both to one another and to the services and programs they need. Family Connections has the skills and the expertise and certainly the desire to make that happen. Your continued support can make it a reality.

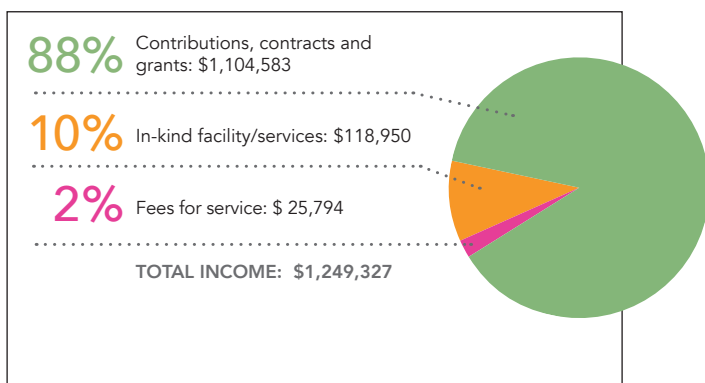

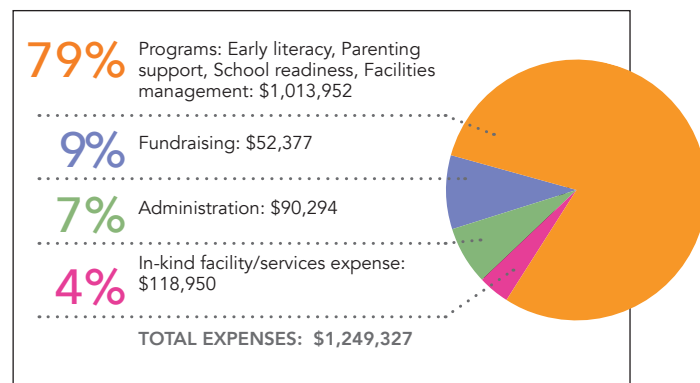

2012 PROGRAMS



EARLY LITERACY

Research shows that parent-child activities and interactions play an important role in a child's language and literacy development.

(Tabors, Snow, & Dickinson, 2001)

At our library-based literacy playrooms, families learn important literacy skills, have fun, read and play together with instruction and guidance from our experienced staff.

In 2012, 795 families visited our literacy playrooms a total of 7,502 times.



SCHOOL READINESS

Research demonstrates the need to show parents and caregivers how to provide early literacy experiences for and with their children both at home and in their daily activities. In so doing, parent involvement programs that include these type of early learning experiences can have significant impact on later school achievement, emotional and social well-being.

(Strickland & Riley-Ayers, 2006)

Family Connections works with families during the critical transition to kindergarten and follows them through their kindergarten experience to strengthen their literacy and reading skills. We provide group activities for parents and children

together, home visits with parents and children in their homes and classroom-based support for kindergarten students.

In 2012, our staff provided 519 families with school readiness services. A total of 834 home visits took place in 2012.

PARENTING SUPPORT

The Center of the Study of Social Policy underscores the importance of effective parenting knowledge, social connections, positive parent and child relationships, parental resilience and feeling competence in the parenting role. These are needed to strengthen families.

(Fraser & Galinsky, 2004)

Families receive parenting support through a variety of Family Connections programs both in their homes and in our playrooms and classrooms. We serve families with new babies and those with pre-school age children with special needs.

We provide all parents with the opportunity to connect and build supportive relationships with our staff and other parents in their communities. We share community resources with parents who may need specific additional supports and share relevant information about parenting and child development. All parents and caregivers are welcome to learn and grow with their children at Family Connections.

During 2012, 488 families received Parent Support services.
